



AΩA Volunteer Clinical Faculty Award

Alpha Omega Alpha's Volunteer Clinical Faculty Award recognizes community physicians who contribute to the education and training of clinical students.

Awardees receive a framed certificate from Alpha Omega Alpha, an engraved AΩA key ring and their name is added to a plaque that hangs in the Dean's office of the school where they volunteer.

Recipients of the award are eligible to receive it only once.

Nominees need not be members of AΩA, however, if they are a member they must have active status.

Nominations for the Volunteer Clinical Faculty Award may be made by all clinical students, with the recipient chosen by student members of the AΩA Chapter. The AΩA Councilor at each school is responsible for implementation of the process for nomination.
