



2018 ΑΩΑ Robert J. Glaser Distinguished Teacher Award

Purpose

To recognize outstanding educators in the field of medical education.

Background

The award recognizes outstanding contributions to the education of medical students by four faculty members at LCME-approved schools of medicine: two educators from basic science, preclinical departments, and two from clinical disciplines. The recipients will be recognized at the annual Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) Awards Dinner.

The Award

Four recipients will each receive a \$10,000 award. In addition, each recipient's nominating institution will receive \$2,500 for teaching activities. If a school has an ΑΩΑ Chapter, \$1,000 will be awarded to the Chapter. Recipients' travel expenses related to attendance at the AAMC Awards Dinner will be reimbursed by ΑΩΑ. Recipients must submit a W-9 form to the ΑΩΑ National Office prior to the issuance of the award check.

Eligibility: Nominees will be vetted by a review committee composed of past award recipients. Medical schools whose nominee receives a Distinguished Teacher Award will not be eligible to submit another nominee for three subsequent years. Each nominee's application, bibliography, and curriculum vitae must be submitted by **April 6, 2018**, to:
