



2019 Medical Student Service Leadership Project Grant

Alpha Omega Alpha is committed to preparing future leaders in medicine and health care. Leadership is about making a positive difference and can be developed through education, observation, experience, and by working with leader mentors. Service learning provides excellent opportunities for students to develop as servant leaders. Only one team from each school may be nominated.

The award is a three-year grant with each winning team's medical school/institution receiving \$5,000 the first year, \$3,000 the second year, and \$1,000 the third year. The grant will be paid to the sponsoring institution. Payee name must be included in the application. The grant funding may not be used to pay for indirect costs.

Eligibility:

- A team of students at a school with an AQA Chapter or association.
- Proposals with matching institutional or dean's funds will be given priority consideration.
- Only one proposal may be awarded to an institution every three years.
- Applications must be for new projects with the potential to generate future support from the medical school or other sources, not supplemental funding for existing programs. A new component of an existing program is eligible.
- All AQA members in the submission packet must have active status.

Requirements:

- A service learning project for an underserved population, or a service project related to professionalism in a school, hospital, or clinic.
- A description about how the program, mentor, and service learning experience will teach leadership.
- A detailed description of the ways in which the project will incorporate leadership development into the curriculum/experience.
- A detailed description of regular team meetings with the mentor related to leadership, service, and reflection.
- Submission of an annual progress report, and a final report to the AQA National Office upon completion of the third year.
- Funding for the second year and third year is contingent on acceptance of the report for the previous year's work.

Application to the Councilor:

The Councilor and his/her selection committee will choose the proposal judged to be the most promising and with a high probability of completion. The following must be submitted:

1. The completed submission form (see attached).
2. A four-page description of the project with a detailed budget written by the student team leader. Details of the role of the students in project preparation and execution must be provided.
3. Description of the team, team leaders, and leadership components, including ways in which students will have opportunities to develop leadership skills.
4. Description of AΩA Chapter role in project (if applicable).
5. Description of the role of the faculty mentor(s)/advisor(s), and leadership curriculum for the students.
6. A letter of support from the faculty mentor(s) that indicates the commitment of time and interest to the project, the students, and leadership development.
7. Faculty mentor biosketch(es), maximum four pages.

Application to the National Office:

The final proposal selected must be sent to the National Office, and must include, in addition to the above items:

1. A letter of endorsement from the AΩA Councilor.
2. A Dean's endorsement that comments on the student team leader's achievements and potential, and the suitability of the faculty sponsor for mentoring.
3. Commitment of matching funds by the Dean or school.

All materials must be submitted as a single PDF in the format listed on the checklist. Incomplete applications will not be considered. E-mail the application to msslp@alphaomegaalpha.org, no later than **February 15, 2019**.
