



# 2019 Robert J. Glaser Distinguished Teacher Award

Recognizes outstanding educators in the field of medical education.

The award is presented to two educators from basic science preclinical departments, and two from clinical disciplines. The recipients are recognized at the annual Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) Awards Dinner. The recipients' travel expenses related to attendance at the AAMC Awards Dinner are reimbursed by AΩA.

Each recipient receives a \$10,000 award. In addition, each recipient's institution receives \$2,500 for teaching activities, and the AΩA Chapter receives \$1,000. Recipients must submit a W-9 form to the AΩA National Office prior to the issuance of the award check.

Award recipients are selected by a meritorious committee composed of the previous year's award recipients and two prior award winners.

Medical schools whose nominee receives a Distinguished Teacher Award will not be eligible to submit another nominee for three subsequent years. Each nominee's application, bibliography, and curriculum vitae must be submitted by **April 5, 2019**, to:
